Our scholarship recipient will be an older high school student or beginning college student who has already established an interest in the theatre. It can be used to pursue higher level education in any aspect of theatre from acting to directing to design.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Current high school student or one (1) year post graduation from high school.
- Applicants must be pursuing the performing arts (drama, dance, theatre, vocals, etc.)
- Does not have to have participated in a Mooresville Community Children's Theatre (MCCT) production, workshop or program.

Application Requirements:

- Complete and sign the application
- Attach two (2) personal letters of recommendation. These should be from people other than family members. At least one of these letters should be from a person who has some knowledge of your skills as a performing artist or aspirations.
